

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 96-201, "Support of Pima Youth Partnership Families
for Families Project")**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-089

1 **WHEREAS, Pima YOUTH Partnership, a private, not-for-profit prevention agency established in**
2 **1990, has served the youth, families and communities in the Three Western Districts**
3 **of the Tohono O'Odham Nation since 1996 under Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
4 **Council Resolution No. 96-201 dated May 16, 1996; and**

5 **WHEREAS, on September 4, 2003, Pima YOUTH Partnership (PYP) was awarded a grant in the**
6 **amount of \$205,907.00 from Community Partnership of Southern Arizona for the**
7 **Prevention T-Himdag II Project to the communities in five Districts and in all Fifth**
8 **Grade classes on the Tohono O'Odham Nation to meet the following Goals and**
9 **Objectives;**

10 **GOAL ONE: Increase Community Cohesion**

11 **Objective 1.1 Increase a sense of belonging**

12 **Objective 1.2 Increase positive community conditions**

13 **Objective 1.3 Increase positive community actions**

15 **GOAL TWO: Increase Attachment to School of 5th Grade Students**

16 **Objective 2.1 Increase school bonding of 5th Grade Students**

17 **Objective 2.2 Increase school commitment of 5th Grade Students**

18 **Objective 2.3 Increase grade point averages of 5th Grade Students**

20 **GOAL THREE: Decrease Norms, Laws and Policies Favorable to Substance Abuse**

21 **Objective 3.1 Decrease norms favorable to substance abuse**

22 **Objective 3.2 Decrease attitudes favorable to substance abuse**

23 **Objective 3.3 Increase knowledge of impact of norms, laws and policies favorable**
24 **to substance abuse; and**

25 **WHEREAS, Samuel Fayuant, representing PYP as Community Development Director of this**
26 **project, and Linda Fayuant, representing PYP as Youth Development Director of this**
27 **project, presented the Scope of Work as outlined in the attached *Abstract and***
28 ***Supplemental Information* to the Gu Vo and Pisinemo District Councils requesting**
29 **Letters in Support of continuing services in those districts; to Gu Achi, Schuk Toak**
30 **and Sells Districts for Resolutions approving the expansion of services to those**
31 **districts; and presented to the Tohono O'Odham Papago Agency Schools Board of**

1 Directors and the Indian-Oasis Baboquivari Unified School District Number 40
2 Governing Board; and

3 WHEREAS: PYP has received Letters of Support from Pisinemo District Council, Gu-Vo District
4 Council, the Tohono O'Odham Papago Agency Schools Board of Directors, the Indian
5 Oasis-Baboquivari Unified School District No. 40; and supporting Resolutions from
6 Schuk Toak and Sells Districts. (The Gu Achi District Council Resolution is pending,
7 awaiting their vote on February 27, 2004); and

8 WHEREAS: the T'Himdag II Project proposal has received the support of the Legislative Human
9 Resources Development Committee and the Education Department Director of the
10 Tohono O'Odham Nation.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby
12 support the T-Himdag II Project of Pima Youth Partnership as outlined in the
13 attached PYP *Abstract and Supplemental Information*.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD. Day
15 of MARCH, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,376.1 FOR; -0-
16 AGAINST; 253.6 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
17 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
18 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
20 Stat. 984).


