

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Submission of eight journal manuscripts reporting findings from the National Pathways Project, conducted in part with the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-121

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has always viewed the healthcare and well-being of the**
2 **children of the Nation as a priority of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 96-026: "Approving**
4 **Nation's participation in a Five-Year Pathways Full Scale project to prevent Early**
5 **onset in Diabetes in school children funded by the National Heart/Lung and Blood**
6 **Institute"; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, in partnership with the Gila River Indian Community**
8 **and the University of Arizona, has been an active participant in the "Obesity**
9 **Prevention in American Children" project; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the manuscripts titled:**

- 11 ***1. Physical activity as a predictor of body composition in American Indian children;***
- 12 ***2. Intervention-related bias in reporting of food intake by fifth-grade children***
13 ***participating in an obesity prevention study;***
- 14 ***3. How closely do school menus and recipes reflect the nutrient intakes of children***
15 ***at school lunch? Results from the Pathways study;***
- 16 ***4. Design, Implementation, and Quality Control in the Pathways American-Indian***
17 ***Multicenter Trial-rev 4/23/03;***
- 18 ***5. Pathways Curriculum and Family Interventions to Promote Healthful Eating and***
19 ***Physical Activity in American Indian Schoolchildren;***
- 20 ***6. Indices of Changes in Adiposity in American Indian Children;***
- 21 ***7. Lessons Learned From Pathways and Future Directions;***
- 22 ***8. Lessons Learned from the Pathways Process Evaluation.***

23 **were presented by the Pathways Project, and have been reviewed by the Tohono**
24 **O'odham Department of Human Services Research Committee on May 19, 2003; and**

25 **WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Research Committee, Executive Office and the**
26 **Legislative Oversight Committee that the manuscripts provide much information and**
27 **data from the study and a very positive report in their data and findings.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
29 **approves and endorses the submittal of these eight (8) manuscripts to scientific**
30 **journals for consideration of publication.**

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the data and findings shall, where possible, be utilized to prevent
2 obesity in Tohono O'odham.

3 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the data collected shall remain sole proprietorship of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
6 of APRIL, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
7 -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
8 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
9 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
10 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


