1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,
2		now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of
3		constructing, maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation to
4		be owned wholly by the Nation; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did pass Resolution No. 447-90 (Amending
6		the Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Utility Anthority) and
7		Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono
8		O'odham Utility Authority) which requires the Authority to submit for prior review
9		and approval of the Legislative Council and each affected District any proposed utility
10		easement; and
11	WHEREAS,	TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to construct a waterline along the West
12		boundary of the approved Tohono O'odham Nation / Gu-Vo District Youth Recreation
13		Center site; and
14	WHEREAS,	TOUA respectfully submitted a Right-of-Way Map and Legal Description as pertinent
15		information (incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the
16		authorized purposes of TOUA; and
17	WHEREAS,	the TOUA Tohono O'odham Nation/Gu-Vo District Youth Recreation Center Waterline
18		Right-of-Way and related facilities will be of substantial benefit to the Tohono
19		O'odham Nation and their respective members; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Gu-Vo District Governing Council approved the Right-of-Way request as stated in
21		Resolution No. GV04-002; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee did review the requested Right-of-Way on 29 March
23		2004 and by consensus does recommend further approval thereof by the Tohono
24		O'odham Legislative Council.
25	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
26		approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the TOUA Tohono O'odham
27		Nation / Gu-Vo District Youth Recreation Center Waterline Right-of-Way and related
28		facilities in the location (as more fully described in the referenced Legal Description
29		and Right-of-Way Map) and construction by TOUA or its designated subsidiaries for
30		uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.
