13	WHEREAS,	the office of the Chairwoman has prepared a budget for expenditure of the savings as						
14		attached and incorporated by this reference; and						
15	WHEREAS,	this budget is to be administered by the Nation's Natural Resources Department,						
16		Range Conservation and Management Program.						
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby							
18		authorizes the Chairwoman of the Nation to expend the savings of \$26,969.29						
19	according to the attached budget, with this budget being administered by the Range							
20		Conservation and Management Program of the Nation's Natural Resources						
21		Department.
