

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Monetary Contribution for the O'odham Participating in the
Peace and Dignity Journeys 2004)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 04-161

1 **WHEREAS, the Peace & Dignity Journeys, Tohono O'odham Nation Group (the Group) did come**
2 **before the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on April 13, 2004; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Group did make a presentation for monetary support for the 2004 Peace & Dignity**
4 **Run from Alaska to Panama; and**

5 **WHEREAS, there are currently members of the Tohono O'odham Nation who wish to participate**
6 **on behalf of the Nation, their respective districts, their communities, their families**
7 **and themselves; and**

8 **WHEREAS, a proposal was submitted to the Council; and**

9 **WHEREAS, this council does support the Peace & Dignity Journeys 2004 and recognizes that this**
10 **contribution is just a small portion of requested amount; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Group is encouraged to also seek donations from other entities.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council at this time**
13 **hereby currently authorizes a donation in the amount of \$2,500 to be contributed to**
14 **aid the participants of the Tohono O'odham Nation in the Peace & Dignity Journeys**
15 **2004.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the contribution amount of \$2,500 will be allocated from the Tohono**
17 **O'odham Legislative Branch's Donation Line Item and that the \$500 cap be waived to**
18 **support the Peace & Dignity Journey 2004.**

19 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day of**
20 **APRIL, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,992.1 FOR; 637.6 AGAINST;**
21 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
22 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
23 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
24 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
