

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the San Xavier District Housing Department's Application of \$48,000 to the USDA Rural Housing Preservation Grant Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-176**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the mission of the San Xavier Housing Department is to ensure that San Xavier**  
2 **District community members have better living conditions in their housing, and**  
3 **ensure the integrity and quality of District construction projects; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, Housing Department funds repairs to district homes through the HIAP Program; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Housing Committee reviews applications to the HIAP program and**  
6 **has created a priority list of home repairs required within the San Xavier community;**  
7 **and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, HIAP funds are not sufficient to pay for all of these repairs; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the USDA Rural Housing Preservation Grant (RHPG) Program offers money for the**  
10 **repair of homes in rural areas such as the San Xavier District; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District, as a political subdivision of an Indian Nation, is eligible for**  
12 **this grant program; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Housing department wishes to apply for RHPG money to repair to the top five**  
14 **priority homes for a total cost of \$64,000; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, HIAP can cover 25% of the cost of repairing these homes, or \$16,000, and the**  
16 **remainder, or \$48,000, can be requested from the RHPG; and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier Grants Manager contacted the Nation's Grant and Contracts Officer**  
18 **and the Nation's Planning Department before applying, to assure that no Nation's**  
19 **program were applying for this money; and**
- 20 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has passed a resolution in support of this grant**  
21 **application, committing the District's in-kind contribution in FY 2005 and freeing the**  
22 **Nation from any and all liability that may arise due to activities conducted under this**  
23 **grant.**
- 24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does**  
25 **accepts, and supports the SXD Housing Department's application for \$48,000 from**  
26 **the 2004 USDA RHPG program.**
- 27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that, should the District be awarded, the Tohono**  
28 **O'odham Nation will be indemnified and held harmless from any liability that may**  
29 **arise due to activities conducted by the San Xavier District and its subcontractors**  
30 **under the USDA RHPG program.**


