**RESOLUTION NO. 04-180** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has previously supported the Nation's
2		Education Department in submitting a grant proposal and establishing a vocational
3		rehabilitation program under Resolution No. 98-202; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under the Rehabilitation Services
5		Administration's Section 121 (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for
6		American Indians with Disabilities) of the Rehabilitation Act and received grant
7		notification number H250G980011; and
8	WHEREAS,	three new line items will be added to budget amendment/modification which are: 1)
9		750 Major Capital Equipment; 2) 892 Non-Major Capital Equipment; 3) 810
10		Professional Services; and
11	WHEREAS,	services under the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program will
12		be provided to eligible American Indians with disabilities who reside on the Tohono
13		O'odham Nation, with enrolled Tohono O'odham members being priority; and
14	WHEREAS,	the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,
15		priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities, and informed choice so that they may
16		prepare for and engage in gainful employment; and
17	WHEREAS,	a carryover forward of \$62,432.73 has been identified from FY 2003 and is being
18		included into the current program budget of \$409,802.33, which will increase the
19		budget to \$472,235.06.
20	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the FY
21		2004 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program budget in the
22	v	amount of \$472,235.06 reflecting carry over funds of \$62,432.73.
23	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
24		Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairwoman is authorized to execute and expand the
25		grant award to September 30, 2004, and provide continued culturally appropriate
26		vocational rehabilitation services to its eligible consumers, provided however, that
27		any amendments affecting the funding level of this grant shall be submitted for
28		further approval.
