


**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Tabling the Financial Request from the San Xavier Cooperative Association to the June**  
**General Session and devote one full day to the issue)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 04-202**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "establish rules**  
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council" pursuant**  
3 **to Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**  
4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council heard the presentation from the San Xavier Cooperative**  
5 **Association regarding the financial request for \$6 million dollars from the SAWRSA;**  
6 **and**  
7 **WHEREAS, there were numerous questions from Council members regarding the request and**  
8 **the financial debt of the Association to the Nation; and**  
9 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council tabled this presentation to the June General Session and**  
10 **devote one full day to address the issue regarding the financial request and debt to**  
11 **the Nation.**  
12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that**  
13 **it hereby tables the financial request to the June General Session and devote one full**  
14 **day to address all the issues including the debt to the Nation.**

15 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day of**  
16 **MAY, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,323.0 FOR; 1,047.45**  
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
18 **Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
19 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
21 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
