9		Services Master Plan"; and				
10	WHEREAS,	Tucson Area Indian Health Service consulted and contracted services from the				
11		INNOVA group for such data analysis and planning purposes; and				
12	WHEREAS,	the INNOVA group has presented a Preferred Recommendation and various				
13		alternatives for long term facility and service delivery in the Tucson Area; and				
14	WHEREAS,	the "Health Service Master Plan" focuses solely on delivery of services but does not				
15		address the funding sources and financial data required to make an informed				
16		decision on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and				
17	WHEREAS,	a primary concern is that no further Tohono O'odham healthcare resources be				
18		impacted or eroded.

20		1. The Tohono O'odham Nation requests that Financial data specific to the regional				
21		plan and the alternate scenarios be provided to the Tohono O'odham Nation by
