

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In support of the Cooperative Agreement with State of Arizona Rehabilitation Services Administration)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-209

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program (TONVR) provides**
2 **vocational rehabilitation services for enrolled Tohono O'odham Nation members**
3 **with disabilities residing on or near the Nation, and other federally recognized**
4 **American Indians residing on the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the TONVR program funds its activities through Federal Section 121 grants**
6 **authorized according to Title I of the Rehabilitation Act to serve members of the**
7 **Tohono O'odham Nation and informs the Legislative Council that the State of Arizona**
8 **through the Rehabilitation Services Administration, is obligated to provide services**
9 **to the Tohono O'odham Nation members as they are citizens of the State of Arizona;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, the TONVR program desires to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the**
12 **Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) to ensure that the members of the**
13 **Tohono O'odham Nation receive adequate service and representation from both the**
14 **RSA and the TONVR program, such as coordinate technical assistance and training**
15 **opportunities between the programs without harming the services and opportunities**
16 **available to clients from both programs; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council recognizes that the Cooperative Agreement between the RSA**
18 **and TONVR outlines the coordination and provision of client service, program**
19 **technical assistance, and employee cross-training opportunities between the**
20 **programs and supports the purpose and goals of the Cooperative Agreement.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that**
22 **it hereby approves the intent and purposes of the Cooperative Agreement between**
23 **the Rehabilitation Services Administration of Arizona and the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program as attached hereto.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby**
26 **authorizes the Chairwoman, or in her absence the Vice-Chairman, to sign documents**
27 **necessary to effectuate the intent and purpose of this Resolution.**
