

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In approval of the FY 2004 Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Information and Technology Budget Amendment/Modification)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-216

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Information and Technology in meeting the needs and objectives**
2 **of FY 2004, has identified savings in its 620 - Fringe Benefits line item; and**

3 **WHEREAS, three new line items will be added to budget amendment/modification which are : 1)**
4 **723 Uniforms; 2) 772 Repair and Maintenance Buildings; 3) 855 Consumables; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the addition of new line items will provide active wear for all technical and**
6 **professional staff for security purposes and professionalism; and will provide**
7 **funding to establish a computer laboratory for training of Nation's employees, a**
8 **Network Operations Center (NOC), asset management facility and office space for**
9 **DoIT staff; and will provide water and other nutrition for technical staff during the**
10 **summer months; and**

11 **WHEREAS, services under the Tohono O'odham Nation's Department of Information and**
12 **Technology will provide technical assistance and consultation to be provided to the**
13 **Executive Branch programs, departments and districts to support their overall**
14 **missions and objectives through the use of technology.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **FY 2004 Tohono O'odham Nation's Department of Information and Technology**
17 **request for budget amendment/modification reflecting the three new line items: 1)**
18 **723 Uniforms; 2) 772 Repair and Maintenance Buildings; 3) 855 Consumables.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
20 **of JUNE, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
21 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**
22 **(d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**
