

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorization of the Office of Chief Information Officer as Highest-ranking Information Technology Official for the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-217

1 WHEREAS, the federal Government Domain and Registration Services under the General  
2 Services Administration requires a letter of authorization from the "highest ranking  
3 information technology official" to the Chief Information Officer representative for  
4 Indian Affairs to register and establish a domain name for the Native Sovereign  
5 Nations (NSN) government domain use; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation - Executive Branch established the Department of  
7 Information and Technology to serve as the sole and central information and  
8 technology department for the entire Executive Branch; and

9 WHEREAS, the office of the Chief Information Officer serves as the highest-ranking information  
10 technology official for this department; and


11 WHEREAS, for the sole purpose of establishing and registering government domain names for  
12 the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Office of the Chief Information Officer of  
13 Indian Affairs, Department of the Interior.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
15 request that the office of Chief Information Officer of the Tohono O'odham Nation is  
16 authorized to request approval of for submitted domain name(s) for the Tohono  
17 O'odham Nation.

18 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
19 Nation's official, to wit: the Chief Information Officer is authorized to execute any  
20 documentation for the sole purpose of establishing government domain names for  
21 the Tohono O'odham Nation, provided however, that any amendments affecting this  
22 authorization shall be submitted for further approval.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day  
24 of JUNE, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
25 -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of  
26 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
27 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
28 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
