

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment No. 2 to Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-236

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 03-424, the Legislative Council authorized funding of the**
2 **Office of Attorney General and other Executive Branch programs for the six-month**
3 **period from October 1, 2003 to March 31, 2004; and**

4 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 03-506, the Tohono O'odham Nation**
5 **(the "Nation") entered into an Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services**
6 **(the "Attorneys") for the purpose of providing legal representation to the Nation in**
7 **connection with Indian Child Welfare Act proceedings in the State of California; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract was in the amount of \$21,000 for the period from October 1,**
9 **2003 to March 31, 2004; and**

10 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 04-042, the Legislative Council authorized funding of the**
11 **Office of Attorney General and other Executive Branch programs for the twelve-**
12 **month period ending September 30, 2004; and**

13 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 04-082, the Legislative Council approved Amendment No. 1**
14 **to the Attorney Contract which increased the Contract amount from \$21,000 to**
15 **\$55,000 and extended the Contract term through September 30, 2004; and**

16 **WHEREAS, additional funding is required to continue representation of the Nation by the**
17 **Attorneys under the Attorney Contract; and**

18 **WHEREAS, attached hereto is Amendment No. 2 to the Attorney Contract which increases the**
19 **Contract amount from \$55,000 to \$80,000; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the budget of the Office of Attorney General (01-1031-810) has sufficient funds for the**
21 **increased Contract amount; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees recommend approval by the**
23 **Legislative Council of Amendment No. 2 to the Attorney Contract.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

25 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves Amendment No. 2 to the**
26 **Attorney Contract, in the form attached hereto, which increases the Contract**
27 **amount to \$80,000.**

28 **2. Funding for Amendment No. 2 shall be provided from the budget of the Office of**
29 **Attorney General (01-1031-810).**

30 **3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute Amendment**
31 **No. 2.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day of JUNE, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


