

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2005 Distribution of Gaming Revenues by Population Distribution)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-324

1 **WHEREAS, during the July 16, 2004 General Session, the Chairwoman did present three options**
2 **on the distribution of gaming revenues for consideration by the Legislative Council:**
3 **1) equal distribution; 2) population distribution; and 3) 50/50 distribution (½ equal**
4 **and ½ population)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the original preliminary District distribution projection reports (Report 1) were**
6 **provided to all District Chairpersons and Legislative Council Members on May 19,**
7 **2004 and were presented to the District Chairpersons on June 9, 2004; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the updated preliminary District distribution projection reports (Report 2) are**
9 **attached and represent an increase of \$8,951.35 in total District distributions; and**

10 **WHEREAS, District distributions are to be disbursed on August 1, 2004 and the final District**
11 **distribution numbers will not be available until August 30, 2004, therefore resulting**
12 **in some minor fluctuations in comparison to Report 2, which is attached; and**

13 **WHEREAS, there was an error in the amount of \$29,562.34 in prior distributions due to the San**
14 **Xavier District, with the corresponding reductions in the other Districts, which is**
15 **included in the projected FY 2005 distributions and is identified in Report 1 and**
16 **Report 2, the later of which is attached; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council does hereby approve distribution of gaming revenues by**
18 **population distribution.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
20 **approves and authorizes the FY 2005 distribution of gaming revenues by population**
21 **distribution.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total calculated District distributions for the period of August**
23 **2003 to July 2004 will be adjusted for the error in prior distributions totaling**
24 **\$29,562.34 as seen in the attached Report 2.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairwoman of the Nation, the Budget & Finance Committee,**
26 **and the Treasurer resolve the amount owed to San Xavier District and that the matter**
27 **be brought back to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval within three**
28 **(3) months.**

6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
7 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
