3		Council Representatives to evaluate the Hickiwan District's financial situation; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Hickiwan District Council held a special session on July 9, 2004 to discuss the
5		financial situation of the District; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Hickiwan District is without sufficient available resources to meet its budgetary
7		needs for FY-2004; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Hickiwan District's share of FY 2005 gaming revenues is estimated to be
9		\$795,871.21; and
10	WHEREAS,	a portion of the Hickiwan District's FY 2005 gaming revenues can be provided to the
11		District through an early distribution; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Hickiwan District Council understands the manner in which FY-2005 funds used
13		in the fourth quarter of FY-2004 will impact its budget for FY-2005.
14	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes an
15		early distribution of gaming revenues to the Hickiwan District in the amount of
16		\$204,102.90.
17	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the Hickiwan
18		District's interim budget, attached hereto, and authorizes the Nation's Treasurer to
19		distribute funds accordingly.
20	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED that the Hickiwan District Council by Resolution #07-02-04 approved an
21		interim budget for the fourth quarter of FY-2004 including both payments that will
22		become due in the fourth quarter of FY-2004 and those that were incurred earlier in
23		FY-2004 but not yet paid.
