RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving an Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Regarding Trust Status for San Lucy Farm)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-340

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") purchased the 3,200 acre Schramm Ranch
2		$near Arizona\ City, Pinal\ County, Arizona, and\ certain\ adjacent\ state\ land\ lease\ rights,$
3		now known as San Lucy Farm (the "Property"), in 1987 pursuant to the provisions of
4		$the {\it GilaBendIndianReservationLandsReplacementAct,PublicLaw99-503,100Stat.}$
5		1798; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Nation requested by Resolution No. 397-87 in November 1987 that the United
7		States acquire the Property in trust for the benefit of the Nation; and
8	WHEREAS,	delays in taking the land into trust have occurred because of (1) a dispute between the continuous (1) a dispute (1)
9		Nation and the United States regarding the allocation of Central Arizona Project
10		$construction \ costs \ to \ the \ Property \ and \ the \ payment \ of irrigation \ charges \ assessed \ by$
11		the Central Arizona Irrigation and Drainage District ("CAIDD"), and (2) the discovery
12		of environmental contamination on the Property; and
13	WHEREAS,	$the \ dispute \ regarding \ the \ allocation \ of \ construction \ costs \ and \ payment \ of \ irrigation$
14		charges was resolved in 1998 through a Cost Allocation Agreement and a Water
15		Service Agreement reached between the United States, CAIDD and the Nation, in
16		$which the issue of whether the existence of liens on the Property prevented the {\tt United}$
17		States from taking the property into trust was resolved and the Nation's repayment
18		obligation for certain construction costs was cancelled or deferred; and
19	WHEREAS,	the environmental contamination matters have been addressed either through
20		completed cleanup or an agreement for future cleanup which is contained in the
21		attached Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Bureau of Indian
22		Affairs, United States Department of the Interior ("Agreement"); and
23	WHEREAS,	the Nation and the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") have jointly performed various
24		environmental surveys and Phase 1 and Phase 2 environmental site assessments on
25		the Property, which have resulted in removal of certain contaminated soils, the
26		relocation of a septic tank, and other remedial actions at the Property; and
27	WHEREAS,	after completion of these environmental site assessments and remedial actions at
28		the Property the BIA has concluded that it is prepared to take the land into trust

RESOLUTION NO. 04-340 (Approving an Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Regarding Trust Status for San Lucy Farm) Page 2 of 3 1 subject to the condition that the Nation, its political subdivisions or enterprises, 2 perform certain remaining corrective actions after the Property is taken into trust; 3 and 4 WHEREAS, the corrective actions identified in the attached Agreement include the demolition 5 of two unoccupied buildings within 180 days after the Property is taken into trust, the 6 prohibition of residential construction within 50 feet of the location of a former 7 underground storage tank, and the agreement of the Nation to prevent use of the 8 water well at the farm headquarters for human consumption so long as the water 9 does not meet federal Safe Drinking Water Act standards; and 10 WHEREAS, the United States has previously stated that the date of trust acquisition, once 11 administratively complete, will be recorded as May 3, 1988, which is the date of the 12 warranty deeds conveying the Property to the United States in trust for the Nation; 13 and 14 WHEREAS, this Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the San Lucy District Council, the 15 Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Board, and the Natural Resources and 16 Agriculture Committees of the Legislative Council. 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council: 18 1. Approves the Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Bureau of 19 Indian Affairs, United States Department of the Interior, substantially in the form 20 attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairwoman of the Nation to execute the 21 Agreement. 22 2. Renews its request to the Department of the Interior, first stated in Resolution No. 23 397-87 in November 1987, to take the San Lucy Farm property into trust for the 24 benefit of the Nation, and requests that the Department of the Interior complete 25 this action as soon as possible. The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19^{TH} . Day 26 of <u>JULY, 2004</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,367.1</u> FOR; <u>179.45</u> 27 AGAINST; 83.15 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 28 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono 29 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 31 32 Stat. 984).
