1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 03-298 entitled
2		"Opposing the Transfer of Customs Patrol Officers (Shadow Wolves) to the Bureau of
3		Customs and Border Protection (BCBP)" advocating the Shadow Wolves remain in the
4		Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (BICE) both under the US
5		Department of Homeland Security; and
6	WHEREAS,	Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 03-298 describes the history,
7		purpose and contributions of the Customs Patrol Officers nationally known as the
8		Shadow Wolves; and
9	WHEREAS,	regardless of the Tohono O'odham Nation's effort to keep the Customs Patrol Officers
10		(Shadow Wolves) under the BICE, the federal government has placed these officers
11		under BCBP; and
12	WHEREAS,	US Representative Mark Souder is proposing the transfer of existing Customs Patrol
13		Officers (CPO) Unit and establishment of new CPO Units in the Bureau of Immigration
14		and Customs Enforcement; and
15	WHEREAS,	US Representative Souder's proposed amendment requires the Secretary of
16		Homeland Security transfer to the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement
17		all functions of the Customs Patrol Officers unit of the Bureau of Customs and Border
18		Protection operating on the Tohono O'odham Indian Reservation (commonly known
19		as the "Shadow Wolves" unit); and
20	WHEREAS,	the Chairwoman of the Nation supports this Amendment and has reviewed and
21		discussed the proposed Amendment with the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
22	NOW, THER	REFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and the
23		Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the Amendment in US
24		Homeland Security Authorization Bill to transfer the Shadow Wolves from the Bureau
25		of Customs and Border Protection (BCBP) to the Bureau of Immigration and Customs
26		Enforcement (BICE).
