

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting Special Session - August 16, 2004 to Address the Financial Request from the
San Xavier Cooperative Association)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 04-356

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham legislative Council is vested with the power to "establish rules**
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council" pursuant**
3 **to Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**


4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has heard the presentation from the San Xavier Cooperative**
5 **Association regarding the financial request for \$6 million dollars from SAWRSA; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council denied the request at the June General Session and**
7 **subsequent discussion have since taken place with the parties regarding the financial**
8 **request and debt to the Nation.**


9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby sets**
10 **a Special Session on August 16, 2004 to address the financial request from the San**
11 **Xavier Cooperative Association.**

12 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD Day of**
13 **AUGUST, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
14 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of**
15 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
16 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
17 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
