

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Proceed into Closed Session to address the District Audit Findings)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 04-387

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's agenda for the August 09, 2004 General**
2 **Session did include the item, District Audit Findings; and**

3 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1.F - Closed Session, the Council may**
4 **vote to proceed into closed session during which time only the Legislative**
5 **Representatives, its Officers, persons providing testimony or advice, and others the**
6 **Legislative Council may feel to be appropriate shall be present; and**

7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.F.1.E, Council may proceed into closed session on, "Matters that**
8 **may affect the integrity, sovereignty and security of the Nation"; and**

9 **WHEREAS, a motion was made to proceed into closed session to address the District Audit**
10 **Findings and to include the District Chairpersons and the Nation's Chairwoman and**
11 **Vice Chairman. Further that district audits be addressed separately and in**
12 **alphabetical order and that authorized district officials be called in as their**
13 **respective district audits are being addressed.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **proceeds into closed session to address the District Audit Findings and to include the**
16 **aforementioned parties and to proceed in the manner recommended.**

17 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day of**
18 **AUGUST, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,500.25 FOR; -0-**
19 **AGAINST; 129.45 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
20 **Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
21 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
23 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
