

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Legislative Order No. 03-472, Adopting Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council October 2004 General Session)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 04-456

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Order No. 03-472, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
2 **adopted the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Calendar for June 01, 2004 to May**
3 **31, 2005; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of America Indians will hold its Annual Meeting on October 10-**
5 **15, 2004; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a member in good standing with the National Congress**
7 **of America Indians and should be well-represented at the Annual Meeting; and**

8 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation to reschedule the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
9 **Council October 2004 General Session to the following week of October 18-22, 2004.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
11 **reschedules the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's October 2004 General Session**
12 **from October 11-15, 2004 to October 18-22, 2004.**

13 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH, Day of**
14 **SEPTEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,453.6 FOR; -0-**
15 **AGAINST; 176.1 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
16 **Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
17 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
18 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
19 **Stat. 984).**
