## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Authorizing the Expenditure of Funds Under the Asset Forfeiture Program for Travel Expenses from the Department of Justice Account)

RESOLUTION NO. <u>04-462</u>

1	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 01-128 as amended by Res. No. 04-249,
2		the Nation's Chairperson and the Chief of Police have been authorized to sign and
3		enter into ongoing agreements known as Federal Equitable Sharing Agreements
4		(FESA) with the state and federal governments: U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) and
5		U.S. Department of the Treasury (DOT) to accept assets seized as part of the law
6		enforcements efforts in combating illegal enterprises on the Nations' lands; and
7	WHEREAS,	both parties agreed to be bound by the statutes and guidelines that regulate the
8		$shared\ assets\ and\ certain\ requirements\ for\ participating\ in\ the\ FESA\ programs; and$
9	WHEREAS,	monies received are to be held in separate liability fund accounts and must not be
10		commingled with other state and federal equitable sharing funds received from
11		other state and federal agencies; and
12	WHEREAS,	the federal guidelines require that these monies shall not reduce the Police
13		Departments base budget, but are to be used solely for law enforcement purposes in
14		combating illegal activities; and
15	WHEREAS,	that the  Tohono O'odham Nation Accounting Office is to submit quarterly activity and accounting Office is to submit quarterly activity and the topological property activity ac
16		status reports on these funds to the Domestic Affairs Committee and to submit
17		annual activity and status reports to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and
18	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution No. 03-085 authorization was given to the establishment and
19		main tenance  of  separate  bank  accounts  for  the  purposes  of  participating  in  the  FESA
20		program; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Treasurer established two separate bank accounts with Bank of America for the
22		receipt of funds under the account names of Department of Justice and the
23		Department of Treasury; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Treasurer has  maintained  these  accounts  according  to  the  terms, conditions  and  according  to  the  terms, conditions  and  the  terms  according  to  the
25		internal control standards set forth under the FESA agreements; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has agreed to delete the statement for "in
27		$accordance \ with the \ Nation's \ standard \ appropriations \ and \ budgeting \ processes" \ and$
28		revise the wording to "until the agreements expire by their own terms"; and
