

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "NO" Vote on Proposition 101)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-516

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote on Proposition 101 shall have the effect of providing that the initiative**
5 **or referendum measures that mandate an expenditure of state funds, establish a**
6 **fund or allocate funding for any specific purpose, must also provide for increased**
7 **revenues to cover the costs, which cannot come from the general fund, and permits**
8 **the legislature to reduce the expenditures of state revenues to the amount of funding**
9 **supplied by the identified revenue source; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the tribes of Arizona has successfully participated in the initiative process under the**
11 **current laws of the State of Arizona; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is not compelled to alter the current state laws regarding**
13 **the initiative process.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports a "NO" Vote on**
15 **Proposition 101.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
17 **of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**
