

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "YES" Vote on Proposition 102)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-517

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote on Proposition 102 shall have the effect of allowing the state to license or**
5 **transfer interests in technology or intellectual property created or acquired by state**
6 **funded universities or the Arizona Board of Regents in exchange for ownership**
7 **interests and securities in a company or corporation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, it is anticipated that Proposition 102 will improve our business climate, help create**
9 **new jobs, brings new technologies to market, provides better education, and**
10 **improves the lives of every Arizonan; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation may benefit directly and indirectly by a "YES" vote on**
12 **Proposition 102.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports a "YES" Vote on**
14 **Proposition 102.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
16 **of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,156.3 FOR; 507.95**
17 **AGAINST; 965.45 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
19 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
20 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
21 **Stat. 984).**
