

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "NO" Vote on Proposition 104)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-518

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation
2 members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of
3 America; and

4 WHEREAS, a "YES" vote on Proposition 104 shall have the effect of allowing an initiative petition
5 to be circulated for signatures up to 27 months before the general election and
6 requires the petition to be filed with the secretary of state at least 7 months prior to
7 the election at which it will be voted on; and

8 WHEREAS, the tribes of Arizona has successfully participated in the initiative process under the
9 current laws of the State of Arizona; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is not compelled to alter the current state laws regarding
11 the initiative process.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports a "NO" Vote on
13 Proposition 104.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day
15 of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-
16 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
17 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
18 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
20 Stat. 984).


