

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "YES" Vote on Proposition 105)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-519

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote on Proposition 105 shall have the effect of changing the composition of**
5 **the state board of education by replacing a member of the junior college board with**
6 **a president or chancellor of a community college district and increasing the board**
7 **from 8 to 10 members by adding a charter school owner or administrator and a fourth**
8 **public member; and**

9 **WHEREAS, increasing the board from 8 to 10 increases the opportunity for the Tohono O'odham**
10 **Nation to have representation on the board; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Secretary of State's office did not receive any arguments "against" Proposition**
12 **105.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports a "YES" Vote on**
14 **Proposition 105.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
16 **of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,997.8 FOR; 631.9**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
19 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
20 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
21 **Stat. 984).**


