

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting a "YES" Vote on Proposition 300)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-521

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**
4 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote on Proposition 300 shall have the effect of raising State Legislators'**
5 **salaries to \$36,000 per year; and**
6 **WHEREAS, a "YES" vote on Proposition 300 may have the effect of attracting better and brighter**
7 **individuals.**
8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports a "YES" Vote on**
9 **Proposition 300.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
11 **of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,814.8 FOR; 95.70**
12 **AGAINST; 719.2 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
13 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
14 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
15 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
16 **Stat. 984).**
