

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Endorsing Senator John Kerry for President of the United States)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-522

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of**
3 **America; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Democratic candidate for President of the United States of America John Kerry**
5 **has expressed a desire to strengthening the Government-to-Government relationship**
6 **between the federal government and tribal governments; and**

7 **WHEREAS, John Kerry has pledged to appoint Native Americans to key positions in the White**
8 **House and throughout the administration; and**

9 **WHEREAS, John Kerry supports increase in funding for the Indian Health Service, Tribal**
10 **Colleges, and roads and other infrastructure, among other things important to tribal**
11 **governments.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation endorses the Democratic**
13 **candidate for President Senator John Kerry.**

14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day**
15 **of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.0 FOR; -0-**
16 **AGAINST; 95.70 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
17 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
18 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
19 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
20 **Stat. 984).**
