

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Endorsing Senator John McCain for United States Senate)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-523

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of Tohono O'odham Nation
2 members participating in the democratic process as citizens of the United States of
3 America; and

4 WHEREAS, the Republican candidate Senator John McCain has been supportive of issues
5 important to tribal governments in Arizona; and

6 WHEREAS, Senator McCain has supported the integrity of Indian Gaming, funding for
7 infrastructure, and Indian trust fund reform; and

8 WHEREAS, Senator McCain is a longtime member of the Senate Select Committee on Indian
9 Affairs and is familiar with the concept of Government-to-Government relations
10 between the federal government and tribal government and tribal sovereignty.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation endorses the Republican
12 candidate for United States Senate Senator John McCain.


13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH Day
14 of OCTOBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,818.25 FOR; 278.35
15 AGAINST; 533.1 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
16 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
17 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
19 Stat. 984).


