

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Distribution of Mining Royalties by Population)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-535

1 WHEREAS, during the October General Session, the Budget and Finance Committee did
2 recommend for consideration by the Legislative Council for the distribution of
3 mining royalties and interest accrued to all the districts as follows:

- 4 1. Equal Distribution
5 2. Per Capita/Population
6 3. 50/50; and

7 WHEREAS the amounts of mining royalties available for distribution to the Nation's districts as
8 of July, 2004 including interest accrued from May 30, 2002 through July 2004; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council does hereby approve distribution of mining royalties by
10 population.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby approves and
12 authorizes the distribution of mining royalties by population.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH Day
14 of OCTOBER 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,342.2 FOR; 1,287.5
15 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
16 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
17 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
19 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




