9		list of equipment designated by the Intergovernmental Agreement; and
10	WHEREAS,	the authorized equipment purchases categories are Personal Protective Equipment
11		(PPE), Detection Equipment, Decontamination Equipment, and General Support
12		Equipment; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Tohono O'odham Nation
14		Legislative Council; and
15	WHEREAS,	the original DOJ Grant program period ended July 31, 2004; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has received an extension for the period of performance
17		to end January 31, 2005; and
18	WHEREAS,	the request to approve the DOJ Grant extension has been reviewed by the appropriate
19		committees.
20	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21		extension and authorizes carryover of the remaining balance of the United States
22		Department of Justice 2002 State Domestic Preparedness Grant.
