

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the Arizona Division of Emergency Management Assistant Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-541**

1 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Division of Emergency Management Assistant Grant has distributed**  
2 **grants to counties to fund for emergency operations planning and to enhance the**  
3 **terrorism annex that provides public safety services within their respective**  
4 **jurisdictions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive supplemental funds through the**  
6 **counties, requiring tribes to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements with counties;**  
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated an Intergovernmental Agreement with**  
9 **Pima County for \$10,000.00 on a reimbursement basis to finance for emergency**  
10 **operations by the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety to review and**  
11 **update their emergency operation plan designated by the Intergovernmental**  
12 **Agreement; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Supplemental funding for emergency operations authorized each jurisdiction to**  
14 **review and update their emergency operations plan, develop or enhance a terrorism**  
15 **annex and make the plan compatible and interoperate with the Pima County**  
16 **Emergency Plan; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Office of the Attorney General,**  
18 **Executive Committee, Domestic Affairs Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, and**  
19 **therefore said committees recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
21 **above-mentioned Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County for \$10,000.00 on**  
22 **a reimbursement basis for the emergency operations planning under the Emergency**  
23 **Management Assistant Grant and approves a Waiver of Indirect Cost to administer**  
24 **this grant.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety is**  
26 **authorized to expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$10,000.00 beginning**  
27 **March 23, 2004 through December 15, 2004.**


1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19<sup>TH</sup> Day
