13	WHEREAS,	the Supplemental funding for emergency operations authorized each jurisdiction to					
14		review and update their emergency operations plan, develop or enhance a terrorism					
15		annex and make the plan compatible and interoperate with the Pima County					
16		Emergency Plan; and					
17	WHEREAS,	the Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Office of the Attorney General,					
18		Executive Committee, Domestic Affairs Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, and					
19		therefore said committees recommend approval by the Legislative Council.					
20	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the					
21		above-mentioned Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County for \$10,000.00 on					
22		a reimbursement basis for the emergency operations planning under the Emergency					
23		Management Assistant Grant and approves a Waiver of Indirect Cost to administer					
24		this grant.					
25	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety is						
26		authorized to expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$10,000.00 beginning					
27		March 23, 2004 through December 15, 2004.
