
1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council convened for their scheduled October**
 2 **Session on October 20, 2004; and**
 3 **WHEREAS, the Nation's officials have passed a resolution approving a distribution formula to**
 4 **distribute funds to the Districts; and**
 5 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District's allocation is in the amount of \$987,418.71 for fiscal year 2005;**
 6 **and**
 7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has passed a resolution to continue**
 8 **operation at the Fiscal Year 2004 funding level and that this budget would be brought**
 9 **to the Legislative Council for approval; and**
 10 **WHEREAS, the proposed budget was addressed at all the communities of the district; and**
 11 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Communities have met and passed Community Budgets for direct**
 12 **services to meet community needs; and**
 13 **WHEREAS, the proposed budget was addressed and passed by the Gu Achi District Council.**
 14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
 15 **Gu Achi District's Fiscal Year 2005 Budget attached for the Administration and**
 16 **Communities as listed below:**


1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Gu Achi District FY 2005 is retroactive to October 01, 2004.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH Day
6 of **OCTOBER, 2004** at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-
7 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
8 Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
9 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
11 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
