13		\$106,267.23 for Tribal and \$6,503.03 for non-tribal, for the Legislative Branch, the
14		amount is \$20,368.23 for tribal, and the Executive Branch has been calculated to be
15		\$1,356,822.87, \$432,476.60 for tribal and \$924,346.26 for non-tribal, including
16		adjust ment for attrition, reclassification of positions, additions of new positions and
17		freezing of positions within departments for all tribal and non-tribal programs.
