

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Effective Strategies to Reduce Motor Vehicle Injuries Among American Indians and Alaska Natives and Approving the Centers for Disease Control Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Cooperative Agreement)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-611

1 **WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is a health priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
2 **WHEREAS, the prevalence of motor vehicle injuries and mortality are very high on the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services, the Tohono O'odham Police**
5 **Department and the Indian Health Service - Sells Service Unit are collaborating to**
6 **prevent motor vehicle injuries.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
8 **and approves the grant award in the amount of \$71,634.00 to fund the Effective**
9 **Strategies to Reduce Motor Vehicle Injuries Among American Indians and Alaska**
10 **Natives grant.**


11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Human Services is authorized to expend the**
12 **approved funds in accordance with the attached and approved budget.**

13 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and agrees to**
14 **enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and**
15 **Prevention (CDC) for a period of four years, from September 1, 2004 - August 31, 2008**
16 **in order to prevent motor vehicle injuries on the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman,**
18 **the Vice Chairman or any designated official is hereby authorized to negotiate and**
19 **execute this cooperative agreement.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH Day**
21 **of NOVEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,463.4 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**
