

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting United States Veterans Affairs Office Funds of \$50,000.00 and Approving FY 2005
Veterans Memorial Monument and Park Budget as a Multi-Year Capital Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-618

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the Tohono O'odham Veterans**
2 **Affairs Office through a Tribal subsidy; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Veterans Affairs has provided service to all veterans; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has received \$50,000.00 from the United States Veterans**
5 **Affairs Office to be utilized for expense to build a Veterans Memorial Monument and**
6 **Park within the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Veterans Affairs has prepared the FY 2005 Veterans Affairs**
8 **Office Memorial Park budget to use the funds to cover the expense.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
10 **accepts the FY 2005 Tohono O'odham Nation-Veterans Affairs Office Memorial Park**
11 **Budget at \$50,000.00 to cover expenses. The program will be authorized to expend**
12 **funds upon approval of the grant award. The Tohono O'odham Nation Official, to wit:**
13 **the Chairwoman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the proposal.**

14 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park budget is designated**
15 **as a multi-year Capital Project.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH Day**
17 **of NOVEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,463.4 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
21 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
22 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
