

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Tohono O'odham Participation in the Kitt Peak Wildland Urban Interface**  
**Project and Approving the FY 2005 Budget for the Project)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-619**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation operates a Wildland Fire Management Program within**  
2 **the Tohono O'odham Fire Department funded by Bureau of Indian Affairs under P.L.**  
3 **93-638 Master Contracts No. 1450CTH54T61071, to provide services in fire**  
4 **suppression, prevention, and preparedness on the Nation's lands; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Wildland Fire Management Program has participated with State and**  
6 **Federal agencies including the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife**  
7 **Service, the Bureau of Land Management, the National Science Foundation, and**  
8 **Arizona State Land Department in developing the Kitt Peak Wildland Urban Interface**  
9 **Project to address the risk of wild fires occurring on Kitt Peak; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Kitt Peak Wildland Urban Interface Project, will utilize the Nation's Wildland Fire**  
11 **Management Program personnel and equipment, along with the personnel and**  
12 **equipment of other agencies, to remove fuels surrounding the Kitt Peak mountain**  
13 **range, which will decrease the risk of catastrophic impact from potential wild fires**  
14 **and protect lives, property, and natural resources; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has made available for the Nation funding for FY 2005 for**  
16 **the Nation's participation in the Kitt Peak Wildland Urban Interface, to be expended**  
17 **in FY 2005 through FY 2007 in accordance with the budget; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee have**  
19 **reviewed the budget and recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the BIA, P.L. 93-638**  
21 **Contract for the Kitt Peak Wildland Urban Interface and the attached FY 2005 Budget**  
22 **in the amount of \$381,074.44 and authorizes the program to expend funds as**  
23 **budgeted, and authorizes the Chairwoman of the Nation to execute any**  
24 **documentation reasonably necessary to fund and implement this project.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
26 **of NOVEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,272.0 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 357.7[08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
31 **Stat. 984).**


