

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency 2004 Assistance to Firefighters Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-622**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants to local**  
2 **fire departments through the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Assistance**  
3 **to Firefighters Grant Program to assist in providing public safety services within their**  
4 **respective jurisdictions; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated as eligible to receive funds through the Assistance**  
6 **to Firefighters Grant Program; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has applied for a grant under this Program on April 2,**  
8 **2004, with the intent of replacing old, broken, and outdated breathing apparatus that**  
9 **protect the firefighters while operating at emergency scenes; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant to purchase such equipment**  
11 **on a match basis of ninety percent from Federal funds and ten percent from the**  
12 **recipient (Tohono O'odham Nation); and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has allocated the ten percent share**  
14 **amount within the Department's Fiscal Year 2005 Budget and requests a Waiver of**  
15 **Indirect Costs associated with administering this grant; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department requests the acceptance of the awarded**  
17 **grant on a reimbursement basis; and**
- 18 **WHEREAS, the grant application and award procedures has been reviewed and approved by the**  
19 **Office of the Treasurer, Office of Grants and Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic**  
20 **Affairs Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, and the aforementioned offices and**  
21 **committees recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**
- 22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
23 **above-mentioned Assistance to Firefighters Grant as it pertains to the attached**  
24 **Tohono O'odham Nation's Fire Department 2005 Fiscal year budget, by way of an**  
25 **appropriation of the Federal grant funds into the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire**  
26 **Department Fiscal Year 2005 Budget for the purchase of equipment under the United**  
27 **States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency**  
28 **2004 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program and approves a Waiver of Indirect Cost**  
29 **to administer this grant.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department is authorized to  
2 **expend funds in the amount of \$99,931.00 from this grant beginning October 1, 2004**  
3 **through September 30, 2005.**

4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Nation does hereby waive the application of its indirect cost rate  
5 **associated with administering this grant.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
7 **of NOVEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,997.8 FOR; 465.6**  
8 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
9 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
10 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
11 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
12 **Stat. 984).**


