12		recipient (Tohono O'odham Nation); and
13	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has allocated the ten percent share
14		amount within the Department's Fiscal Year 2005 Budget and requests a Waiver of
15		Indirect Costs associated with administering this grant; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department requests the acceptance of the awarded
17		grant on a reimbursement basis; and
18	WHEREAS,	the grant application and award procedures has been reviewed and approved by the
19		Office of the Treasurer, Office of Grants and Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic
20		${\bf AffairsCommittee, Budget\&FinanceCommittee, andtheaforementionedofficesand}$
21		committees recommend approval by the Legislative Council.
