

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Planning Department Housing Rehabilitation Project Construction
and Administration Budgets for Fiscal Year 2005)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-626

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council approved the three year funding request of \$9,405,649.93 by**
2 **Resolution No. 01-661; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department's Housing Rehabilitation Project has identified**
4 **\$5,500,668.86 in carry-forward funds from FY-2002, FY-2003, and FY-2004; and**

5 **WHEREAS, over 75% of the homes are completed, delays in budget approvals, I.H.S. project**
6 **scheduling, and District verification of recipients have resulted in it being necessary**
7 **to continue this funding in order to serve the listed clients; and**

8 **WHEREAS, less than 75% of the appropriated funds have been utilized and the Administrative**
9 **Plan calls for expansion of this program to address emergency repairs and warranty**
10 **follow through; and**


11 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department's Housing Rehabilitation Project has consolidated the**
12 **proposed construction and administration budgets for FY-2005 in accordance with**
13 **Resolution No. 01-661 and in the amount of \$1,142,025.29 and \$2,666,167.08**
14 **respectively, as attached and incorporated by this reference, which was presented to**
15 **the Housing Committee and Budget & Finance Committee of the Tohono O'odham**
16 **Legislative Council.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
18 **the proposed attached consolidated construction and administration budgets and**
19 **attachments for FY-2005 in the amount of \$3,808,192.37.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
21 **Chairwoman to execute any and all contracts or agreements with other parties,**
22 **including the Nation's Districts, in order to ensure that projects are completed.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH Day**
24 **of NOVEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,463.4 FOR; -0-**
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
27 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
28 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
29 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
