8		and  Solid  Waste  Management  Plan  on  February  12, 1997  with  Resolution  No.  97-041;

10	WHEREAS,	the TohonoO'odhamSolidWastePlandirectstheSolidWasteManagementProgram
11		to implement a system of collection, recycling and disposal of solid waste, and
12		certain hazardous waste; and collect solid waste fees to help pay for program costs;

15		of solid waste and recycling fees; and
16	WHEREAS,	the  residential  and  commercial  customers  pay  for  some  of  the  program's  costs, and
17		the Nation through tribal budget 01-1097 pays for the remainder of the program's
18		operational costs; and
19	WHEREAS,	to provide solid waste collection service to all residents in all villages of the Nation
20		additional funds are needed beyond that which is provided in the tribal budget 01-
21		1097.
