

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2005 Bureau of Reclamation Fund Account 11-5015 Water Resources
Study Program Continuation under Public Law 93-638
Grant for a Comprehensive Water Study)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-636

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) entered into a Grant Agreement with the United**
2 **States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), Phoenix Area office**
3 **under the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-**
4 **638, for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation,**
5 **designated as Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 (Grant Agreement); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement has been extended for one (1) year beginning on**
7 **October 1, 2004 and expiring on September 30, 2005; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget for fiscal year 2005 in the**
9 **amount of \$446,160.17; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this budget has been reviewed by the Legislative Water Resources Committee and the**
11 **Legislative Budget and Finance Committee and it is recommended for approval by the**
12 **Legislative Council.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
14 **carryover of savings of Bureau of Reclamation funds provided by the P.L. 93-638**
15 **Bureau of Reclamation Grant, for the Water Resources Study Program in the total**
16 **amount of \$446,160.17.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the total budget funding for fiscal year 2005 of \$446,160.17 for the**
18 **Water Resources Study Program is approved in accordance with the budget attached**
19 **hereto.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH. Day**
21 **of NOVEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,463.4 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**

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
