(Approval of the FY 2005 Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services, Division
of Community Health - Women, Infants & Children (WIC) Program Proposed
Budget of \$135,300.00 Account #12-1436)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-644

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the Women, Infants &**
2 **Children (WIC) program which provides preventive health care; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona through an Intergovernmental Agreement**
4 **receives funds from the United States Department of Agriculture for programs**
5 **designed to benefit women, infants and children; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with**
7 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants & Children**
8 **(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2006**
9 **and which was approved through Resolution No. 02-439; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue**
11 **to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of**
12 **individuals at risk; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the WIC has submitted the FY05 WIC budget and proposal in the amount of**
14 **\$135,300.00.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 16 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves and authorizes expenditures of the FY05**
17 **attached budget in the amount of \$135,300.00 from the Inter-Tribal Council of**
18 **Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible women, infants**
19 **and children.**
- 20 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation Official, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice Chairman**
21 **and any designated Official is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**
22 **Memorandum of Agreement associated with this program, provided however,**
23 **that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the Memorandum**
24 **of Agreement shall be submitted for further approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day**
26 **of DECEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,463.4 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**


