9		Enterprise as the tribal enterprise responsible for operating the Nation's gaming				
10		facilities a	nd con	ducting gaming activities in compliance with the requirements of

12	WHEREAS,	Section 8(b)(2) of t	he Charter of the Gaming Enterprise contains the following limited		
13		waiver of t	he Gam	ning Enterprise's sovereign immunity with respect to claims based

16		Colorado corporation ("PeopleSoft"), dated September 30, 2004, to license enterprise			
17		management software from PeopleSoft for use in the Gaming Enterprise's businesses			
18		(the "Contracts"); and			
19	WHEREAS,	the Contracts are expressly conditioned upon the \$500,000 limits in Section 8(b)(2)(A)			
20		and 8(b)(2)(B)(i) of the Charter of the Gaming Enterprise being increased to \$7,000,000

22	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise has requested that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
