

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amendment of Resolution No. 04-636, "Approving the FY 2005 Bureau of Reclamation Fund Account #11-5015 Water Resources Study Program Continuation under Public Law 93-638 Grant for a Comprehensive Water Study"; Authorization to Accept and Expend Public Law 93-638 Bureau of Reclamation Funds for the Water Resources Study Program Six-Month (6) FY 2005 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-687

1 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Study Program of the Tohono O'odham Nation has been
2 conducting a comprehensive water resource study since 1998 under a Public Law 93-
3 638 Grant Agreement with the Bureau of Reclamation of the United States
4 Department of the Interior; and

5 WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement has been extended for one (1) year beginning on
6 October 1, 2004 and expiring on September 30, 2005; and

7 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Study Program has proposed a six-month (6) FY 2005 budget in
8 the amount of \$321,580.19 beginning on October 1, 2004 and expiring on March 31,
9 2005; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Water Resources Committee and the Budget
11 and Finance Committee have reviewed this and recommend approval by the Tohono
12 O'odham Legislative Council.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
14 Water Resources Study Program to:

- 15 1. Amend the Water Resources Study Program Bureau of Reclamation Budget to a
16 six (6) month budget.
- 17 2. Accept the remainder of the Bureau of Reclamation funding of \$321,580.19.
- 18 3. Authorize the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman or designee to expend the attached
19 budget.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day
21 of DECEMBER, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).
