12	WHEREAS,	it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation that the Nation continue its
13		participation in the ITMA and its consultations with ITMA member tribes in order to
14		hold the federal government accountable for its many decades of Indian trust asset
15		mismanagement; and
16	WHEREAS,	the  Budget  &  Finance  Committee, which  has  been  delegated  authority  to  recommend
17		legislative measures concerning the use of funds held in trust by the federal
18		government, has recommended the appointment of Councilperson Evelyn Juan as
19		the  Nation's  ITMA  representative  (Plan  of  Operation  for  Budget  &  Finance  Committee,
20		Article I(b)(3) (1988)); and
21	WHEREAS,	the Budget & Finance Committee has further recommended the appointment of
22		Councilwoman Gloria Ramirez as the Nation's ITMA alternate.
