

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Utility Authority Gu-Vo – Pia Oik Inter-tie Water System,
Gu-Vo District, Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-010

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,**
2 **now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of constructing,**
3 **maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation to be owned**
4 **wholly by the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did pass Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting**
6 **Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) which**
7 **requires the Authority to submit for prior review and approval of the Legislative**
8 **Council and each affected District any proposed utility easement; and**

9 **WHEREAS, in order to serve the community of Pia Oik with reliable domestic water uses it is the**
10 **recommendation of the Indian Health Service (I.H.S.) and the Tohono O'odham Utility**
11 **Authority (TOUA) to construct an Inter-tie Water System from Gu-Vo Community to**
12 **the Pia Oik Community; and**

13 **WHEREAS, TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to construct an Inter-tie Water System**
14 **from the community of Gu-Vo to Pia Oik, Gu-Vo District, Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information**
16 **(incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized purposes**
17 **of TOUA; and**

18 **WHEREAS, The Gu-Vo – Pia Oik Inter-tie Water System and related facilities will be of substantial**
19 **benefit to the communities of Gu-Vo and Pia Oik, Gu Vo District, the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Nation and their respective members; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council supported the Inter-tie Water System proposal**
22 **with Resolution No. GV02-56; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council approved the requested Right-of-Way by**
24 **enacting Resolution No. GV04-122; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee did review the requested Right-of-Way on**
26 **December 27, 2004 and by consensus recommends approval thereof by the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
2 **approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the Gu-Vo - Pia Oik Inter-tie**
3 **Water System and related facilities in the location (as more fully described in the**
4 **referenced map and supporting documents) and construction by TOUA or its**
5 **designated subsidiaries for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03rd. Day**
7 **of JANUARY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
8 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
9 **Section 1 (i) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
10 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
11 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
12 **Stat. 984).**


