

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Expenditure of Funds Under the Asset Forfeiture Program for the
Acquisition of Two (2) Canines Trained for Narcotic/Patrol and Explosive/Patrol,
Handler Training and Travel Expenses from the Department of Justice

RESOLUTION NO. 05-039

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution Nos. 01-128, 03-085, 04-249 concerning the**
2 **use of Asset Forfeiture Funds; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department submits its request for the**
4 **authorization and expenditure of funds to purchase two (2) canines trained in**
5 **Narcotic/Patrol and Explosive/Patrol at a cost of \$8,750 each for a total of \$17,500; and**

6 **WHEREAS, \$7,000 is going to be paid with Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department's FY 2005**
7 **Tribal Budget with the remaining balance of \$10,500 to be paid with Asset Forfeiture**
8 **funds; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the costs associated with travel expenses for two (2) officers consisting of: Per diems**
10 **of \$806.00 each for a total of \$1,612.00 and lodging expenses of \$1,200 each for a total**
11 **of \$2,400.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department is requesting to expend \$18,512.00**
13 **from the Asset Forfeiture Fund Account - Department of Justice.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby accepts and approves the**
15 **authorization and expenditure for the acquisition of two (2) canine units, costs**
16 **associated with handler training and travel expenses for a total budgeted amount of**
17 **\$18,512.00 to be funded from the Asset Forfeiture Fund Account - Department of**
18 **Justice, Account No. 0046-7808-3507.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
20 **of JANUARY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,438.3 FOR; -0-**
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 191.4 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
22 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**


