1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services, Division of Behavioral Health provides substance**
2 **abuse and mental health services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Division of Behavioral Health submitted an application for this project in August**
4 **2004; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Safe and Bright Future, Domestic Violence for Children and Adolescent Planning**
6 **Grant is a planning and design process for a comprehensive system that will reduce**
7 **violence against children, adolescents and provide direct services for the children,**
8 **adolescents and their families; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award was received for Fiscal Year 2005 in the amount of \$75,000.00 for**
10 **the first year of a two- year grant; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Safe and Bright Future, Domestic Violence for Children and Adolescent Planning**
12 **Grant and budget in the amount of \$75,000.00 are hereby submitted for review and**
13 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

15 **1. Hereby approves and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the FY2005**
16 **The Safe and Bright Future, Domestic Violence for Children and Adolescent**
17 **Planning Grant and attached budget in the amount of \$75,000.00 for the first year**
18 **of a two- year grant.**

19 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice**
20 **Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and**
21 **execute the grant.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH, Day**
23 **of JANUARY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,272.0 FOR; 166.3**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 191.4 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
