RESOLUTION NO. 05-051

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the Tohono O'odham Nation**
2 **Youth Council as the official voice for youth of the Tohono O'odham Nation per**
3 **Resolution No. 95-216; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council is requesting for monetary support to**
5 **attend:**

- 6 **1. United National Indian Tribal Youth (UNITY) Mid-Year Conference, February 9 –**
7 **13, 2005, in the amount of \$3,519.76; and the**
8 **2. National Congress of American Indians Executive Council Winter Session,**
9 **February 28 – March 2, 2005 in the amount of \$4,501.00; and**

10 **WHEREAS, a proposal is being submitted to the Legislative Branch for an amount of \$8,020.76 to**
11 **cover airfare, lodging, per diem and registration to send two Youth Council**
12 **representatives and one chaperone.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**
14 **Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council's request for monetary support in the amount**
15 **of \$8,020.76, to be allocated from the General fund, for participation in the following:**

- 16 **1. United National Indian Tribal Youth (UNITY) Mid-Year Conference, February 9 –**
17 **13, 2005, in the amount of \$3,519.76.**
18 **2. National Congress of American Indians Executive Council Winter Session,**
19 **February 28 – March 2, 2005 in the amount of \$4,501.00.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the conclusion of the conferences that any unspent**
21 **portion of the allocated funds be returned to the General Fund.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
23 **of JANUARY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of \$1,704.25 FOR; 734.05**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 191.4 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
